







<u>INNOCENT PIKIRAYI</u>IS PROFESSOR IN ARCHAEOLOGY AND HEAD OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ANTHROPOLOGY AND ARCHAEOLOGY AT THE UNIVERSITY OF PRETORIA. HIS MAIN RESEARCH INTERESTS ARE THE RISE, DEVELOPMENT AND DEMISE OF STATE SOCIETIES IN SOUTHERN AFRICA, DATING TO THE SECOND MILLENNIUM AD, PARTICULARLY GREAT ZIMBABWE, AS WELL AS OTHER STATE SYSTEMS BETWEEN THE ZAMBEZI AND THE LIMPOPO RIVERS.





PROFESSOR TRACY-LYNN FIELD IS AN ENROLLED ADVOCATE AND PROFESSOR IN THE WITS SCHOOL OF LAW.

HER RESEARCH AREAS AND EXPERTISE INCLUDE ENVIRONMENTAL LAW, HUMAN RIGHTS, MINING LAW, CLIMATE CHANGE LAW, WATER LAW, EXTRACTIVES INDUSTRY TRANSPARENCY, MINERAL PROPERTY REGIMES, MINERAL TAXATION REGIMES, AND OPEN GOVERNMENT.

LUQMAN SAKA IS AN ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR AT THE POLITICAL SCIENCE UNIT, UNIVERSITY OF THE GAMBIA, THE GAMBIA AND THE DEPARTMENT OF POLITICAL SCIENCE, UNIVERSITY OF ILORIN, NIGERIA.
